

Checked Bowl

Dimensions: 6"Diameter Base, 12"Diameter at top, 6"H



MATERIALS:

Base: 6" slotted round
Staves: 5/8" FF natural, cut 24 @ 10"
Weavers: 1/4" FO dyed
 #2 RR dyed
 #2 RR natural
Rim: 1/2" FO
 #6 RR dyed
 1/4" FF for lasher

BASE:

Make a paper pattern of the base and fold it in quarters. Use the fold lines to define the quarter points on the base. Insert a stave at each quarter point. Evenly space 5 more staves in each quarter. With #2 RR dyed, twine 4 rows with base flat on the table. Do not end the reed. Add an additional weaver and triple twine for 3 rows, bending up as you weave.

SIDES:

Rows 1-5: 1/4" FO dyed
Rows 6-10: #2 RR, one weaver dyed and one weaver natural, twine
Rows 11-15: #2 RR, reverse the position of the weavers by doing a twist to move the front color to the back
Rows 16-20: #2 RR, reverse the position of the weavers by doing a twist to move the front color to the back
Rows 21-25: 1/4" FO dyed
Rows 26-28: #2 RR dyed, triple twine
Row 29: 1/4" FO dyed as hidden rim row

RIM:

Use 1/2" FO for the inside and outside rims. #6 RR dyed is the rim filler. Double lash with 1/4" FF natural.
