

CORK DRINK / WINE BOTTLE COASTER

Dimensions: 3"D at base, 4.25"D at rim, 1.5" H

MATERIALS:

Spokes: 3/16" FO, cut 27 @ 5.5"
Weavers: 3mm FO
Rim: 3/8" FF, cut 1 @ 16"

4" cork coaster from Ikea - 302.829.46
(comes in packs of 2)
3" slotted round base

BASE:

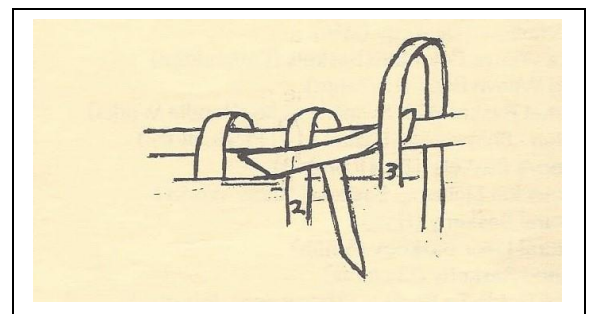
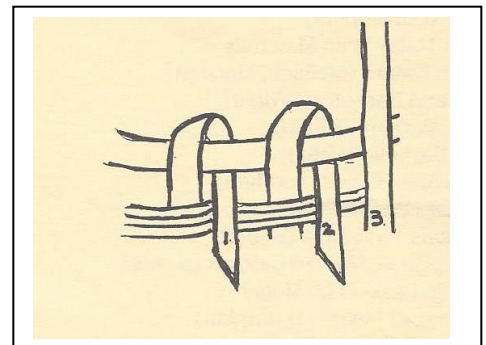
Evenly insert 27 spokes into the base. Glue if you wish.

WEAVING:

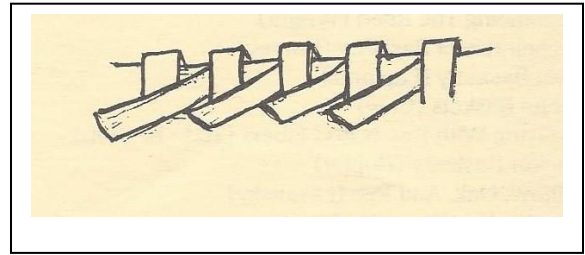
- Narrow a piece of 3mm for an inch or so.
- Weaving is over-under and is continuous.
- Weave until sides match the cork coaster - about 8 or 9 rows.
- You can weave with the cork coaster in place (use double sided tape to hold it in position) or you can insert the coaster after every row to ensure that you are weaving the proper size. If you want to be able to easily remove the coaster, make your weaving loose as the rim wrap slightly extends to the inside of the basket.
- End over the narrowed starting area. Narrow the end of the weaver to match the narrowed beginning of the weaver.

RIM:

- Use a piece of 3/8" FF as the core of the match stick rim. Clip it to the inside of the spokes, about 1/4" above the last row of weaving. Overlap the 3/8" piece about 2".
- Select a spoke and tag it as Spoke 1.
- Fold Spoke 1 over the 3/8" rim. Pull Spoke 1's end under the 3/8" FF and to the front of the basket between Spoke 1 and Spoke 2.
- Do the same procedure on Spoke 2.
- Fold Spoke 1 across the front of Spoke 2 and tuck it behind Spoke 3 (between Spoke 3 and the 3/8" FF). Trim the end of Spoke 1 so it does not show behind Spoke 3. Lock Spoke 1 into position by looping spoke 3 over the 3/8" FF and to the outside of the basket.



- Continue the rimming process around the basket.
